Notice to Candidates

You **must** be on time for your examinations.

You must bring photographic ID to the examination.

You **must not** become involved in any unfair or dishonest practice in any part of the examination; this could lead to malpractice and void your examination result.

You **must not**:

- sit an examination in the name of another candidate.
- have in your possession any unauthorised material or equipment which might give you an unfair advantage.

Possession of a mobile phone or other unauthorised material (See list below) **is breaking the rules**, even if you do not intend to use it. This could lead to malpractice and void your examination result.

- iPods
- Mobile phones
- Smartphones
- MP3/4 players
- Smart Watches / Devices
- Wrist watches which have a data storage device
- Tablet computers
- Web enabled calculators
- Any web enabled devices

You **must not** talk to, attempt to communicate with or disturb other candidates once you have entered the examination room.

You **must** follow the instructions of the invigilator. If you are in any doubt speak to the invigilator.
